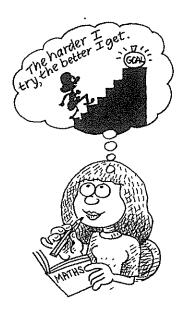

- → Continuing to try, even when schoolwork is hard
- →Not being distracted by others
- ⇒ Checking schoolwork when finished to make sure it is correct
- → Trying and completing work found to be "boring"
- →Listening to teacher's instructions

- ⇒Not giving up too quickly
- ⇒ Doing what you say you are going to do
- → Returning phone calls
- →Putting things away

Things to Say to Encourage Persistent Behaviour

- "You didn't give up!"
- "You kept trying. Great effort."
- "Making that extra effort will help you learn."
- "You sure don't give up easily."
- "Your effort is so important. It will help you succeed."
- · "See, persistence pays off."
- "I see you understand that to be successful, you sometimes have to do things you don't feel like doing."
- "The more you practice, the better you become."



Teach the Following Types of Thinking

- I Can Do It: When trying difficult activities, it is helpful to think you are more likely to be successful than to fail.
- Giving Effort: The harder you try, the more successful you will be.
- Working Tough: To be successful in the future, you sometimes have to do things that are boring or not fun in the present.
